Bicycle Valet Parking



TDM MEASURE:

For all events where the anticipated number of attendees is greater than 1,000 people, the property owner shall provide Monitored Parking for bicycles designed to accommodate at least 20 percent of the event attendees. The monitored bicycle parking must be available to attendees at least one hour before the start of the event until at least 30 minutes after the end of the event. The Monitored Parking for bicycles shall be located within a one block radius of a regular entrance to the event. Since the parking will be temporary in nature, it likely will need to be staffed in order to be properly supplied.

erty owner shall identify a potential space for bicycle valet parking.
coordinator shall facilitate a site inspection by Planning Department staff hat there is suitable space for bicycle valet per the project approvals.
erty owner shall submit a schedule of events held during the last year stamped photographs showing bicycle valet at the events where it ided or receipts with any sensitive billing information redacted showing contracting for bicycle valet services that meet the standards specified in ct approvals, and documentation of marketing materials for the service. Ally, City staff shall provide the TDM coordinator with a copy of the ITDM Plan. The TDM coordinator will provide City staff with a signed being to distribute the TDM Plan via new employee packets, tenant lease atts, and/or deeds.

APPLICABILITY:

This measure is applicable to Development Projects in land use category A that are expected to generate at least 12 events annually with more than 1,000 attendees.
