34 Steiner St. is located on a 57' x 90' lot on the east side of Steiner Street, between Hermann Street and Duboce Avenue. Built ca. 1905, 34 Steiner St. is a 3-story, wood frame, residential-over-commercial building containing seven units. The first-story storefront was infilled in 1983. The rectangular-plan building, clad in stucco, is capped by a flat roof. The primary façade faces west toward Steiner Street and is four bays wide. A secondary elevation faces north toward Hermann Street and is four bays wide. The first floor features recessed entries in the center bays with recessed, arched entries. Each recess shelters two arched, wood doors with transoms. The outer bays contain a recessed picture window in the left bay and a single window in the right bay. The upper stories feature shallow bow windows in the center bays and rounded bay windows at the corners. The Hermann Street elevation has a centered, arched entry in the left center bay and irregular fenestration. The upper stories have semi-hexagonal bay windows in each bay. All upper story windows have undivided, double-hung wood sash. The building terminates in a plain roofline. The building appears to be in good condition.
